Syracuse Spectator Bus - Championships

We would like to offer a spectator bus to Championships on Sunday, October 30th! This is open to any friends and family who would like to go to the show! The coach bus will take you up and drop you off right at the door (no worrying about parking in downtown Syracuse!) then pick you up after our class is done. The bus will leave at approximately 2:30PM, arrive around 7:00PM. Our class begins at 7:58PM and ends around 10:00PM. The bus will leave after the retreat, around 10:30PM, and return at approximately 2:30AM.

For those who have never traveled to Championships before, parking near the Carrier Dome is very tough and expensive (usually \$20+ to park). Taking the spectator bus is a great option for those unfamiliar with downtown Syracuse or those who don't want to deal with planning the day.

In the past the cost has been around \$50 a person. This does NOT include admission. The final cost will be determined by the number of people going.
