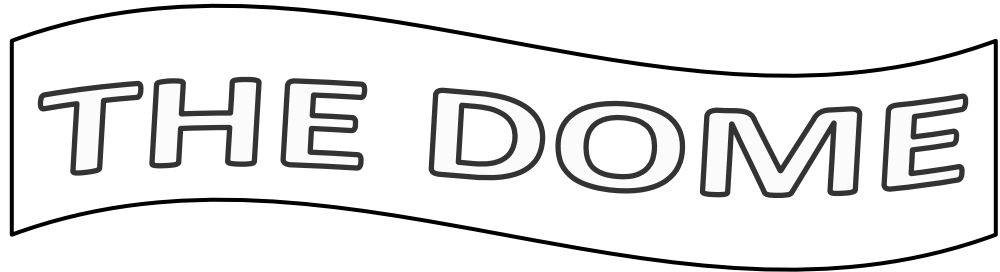

Directions to the Carrier Dome

Take I-90 E to exit 39 toward I-690 E. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for I-690E/Fairgrounds/Syracuse and merge onto I-690E. Take the exit toward W Genesee St. Keep right at the fork to continue toward W Genesee St. Turn left at W Genesee St. Turn right at Oswego Blvd. Slight left at Erie Blvd E. Take the 1st right onto S State St. Turn left on E Genesee St. Turn right onto Irving Ave. Dome is on the left. (900 Irving Ave).
